

Dear UPCS Families,

The 2020-21 school year is rapidly approaching. Our teachers cannot wait to greet their students on the first day of school in Zoom! Teachers, administrators, and staff are busily working to create an engaging experience for students that provides consistency, continuity, and a sense of community. The spring digital learning surveys, completed by families and teachers, provided crucial feedback used in the development of the full distance and hybrid learning models. The California Department of Education has also set standards that all schools must follow when developing online learning.

While creating both the models for instruction and the daily schedules, we did not lose sight of our core values. We asked ourselves, "What is it we want for our children upon return? How do we mitigate learning loss during these challenging times? How do we support them on a social emotional level?" The conclusion is that we do not want to provide a temporary fix. We want to support our students for the end game, coming back to school full-time.

As a core value, we want to be sure our students maintain **continuity** of their program (dual immersion or language enrichment), no matter which model best fits a family. UPCS values the important relationships that students have with their teachers, staff, and fellow students and thus we identified **community** as a core value. To support this, our students will remain with their regular classroom teacher all year, whether in full distance learning or hybrid. Building classroom community and strong learning relationships will support our students now and when we are able to return to campus. Students will engage in daily "class meetings" with their peers allowing for sharing and interaction. It is also a great time for a teacher to do check-ins and talk with students about goal setting, self-reflection, and resilience. These community building practices are essential to a child's well-being now and when we return.

Another core value we hold is **consistency**. We want students to get a sense of what it means to be at school, to establish good learning routines, to interact with their teacher and peers, and to get real-time feedback on learning. Providing students a consistent schedule, regardless of the location of learning, gives students the routines they need to thrive. All learning models include daily live instruction and feedback with schedules that remain consistent in 100% Distance Learning, Hybrid, and back to school full-time.

Our students can seamlessly move from Hybrid to Full Distance, as needed. While we are asking families to make a program choice for the transition to physical reopening, while we are still in 100% Distance Learning, we know that each family's situation may change. We want to assure families that they are NOT locked into the choice they make now. Children may move in and out of each program model as needed. As an example: If a student who is in the Hybrid model were to become affected by COVID 19 and be required to quarantine for a period of time, that student would just go into the full distance learning for the period of the quarantine and then return to school when it is deemed appropriate.

Below, you will find example schedules for each model, 100% Distance Learning and Hybrid. After reviewing the schedules, please follow the link in the Parent Square that was sent to you on August 1, 2020 to complete the Family Survey in Preparation for 2020-21. We also encourage you to attend the Family Information Nights (August 3rd and 4th) to further explain the details of all the schedules and models.



Distance Learning

"Distance Learning" is when students **engage in learning and make academic progress** when they are not physically present in schools. This is accomplished using a **variety of digital and print resources**, and differentiated **modes of interaction** with teachers (and peers, when possible).

Driving Factors for Reopening Decisions

- 1. The health, safety and well-being of students, staff, and families
- 2. Providing teaching and learning options for families
- 3. Ensuring that learning transitions between full distance learning, hybrid, and full return to school are seamless



What will all UPCS instructional models include?

- Rigorous and robust California standards-based instruction meeting the State's instructional minute requirements in all content areas with grades assigned by the teacher.
- Clear schedule and expectations for students, families, and staff
- Consistent teacher instruction, support, and feedback
- The instructional day has been designed to include targeted instructional time, guided practice with the teacher, independent practice off Zoom and breaks where students will not be on Zoom.
- Opportunity for whole group, small group instruction, independent work, and student collaboration both on and off Zoom
- Morning meetings provide time for community building and social/emotional support

- Blocks of time that allow teachers to schedule for individual student needs
- Students in the middle school program will engage in each period of their day
- Teacher office hours for student questions

100% Distance Learning

These schedules will remain in effect from August 24th, 2020 until our school is given permission to open, partially or fully.

Please note these are SAMPLE schedules only and the subject each teacher teaches at a particular time will vary depending on the needs of their class. The schedule was designed to let you know the times of day that your child will be expected to join in online. Attendance will be taken for each period.

Return to School Options

The hybrid schedule will begin when we are given permission to bring students back to physical school in smaller groups that provide for physical distancing protocols. We are asking parents to consider the following options for when we are allowed to physically reopen. We understand that your decision may change and the structure of our models allow flexibility in your decision making.

Choice #1 - Hybrid (Schedules A & B)

Students attend physical school two days a week. Students Zoom-in with their own classes three days a week for key lessons, teacher directed practice with feedback, and small group work. There will also be time for offline independent work and regular breaks.

Choice #2 - Remain 100% Online

Students remain home 100% of the time and digitally join their classes for key lessons, teacher directed practice with feedback, and small group work. There will also be time for offline independent work and regular breaks.
